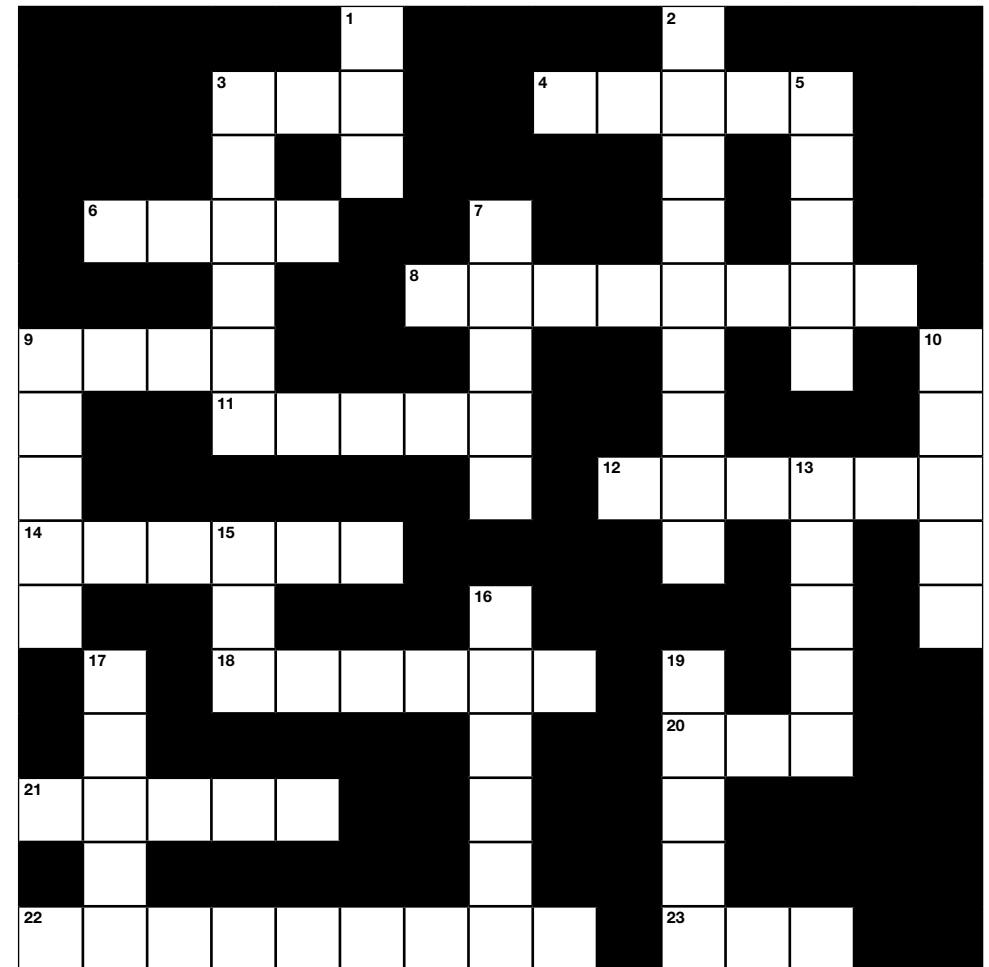

LET'S THINK ABOUT THIS

From reliable history records we know that when King Nebuchadnezzar died, his son Nabonidus became king of Babylon. However, our story begins with Nebuchadnezzar's grandson, Belshazzar, who at the time of our story was co-ruler of Babylon with his father Nabonidus.

Belshazzar was young, self-centred and rebellious. It is therefore not surprising that he also liked big parties which included alcoholic wine, women and ultimately drunken behaviour.

By defiling sacred vessels from the temple, Belshazzar had gone too far in disrespecting God. Everything used in a worship service and dedicated for this use is considered sacred.

LET'S THINK ABOUT THIS

As Daniel was explaining the mysterious writing on the wall, Cyrus, commander of the combined Medo-Persian armies, was already at work with his plans to invade Babylon. Cyrus was the nephew of King Darius the Mede, who eventually became the new ruler over Babylon.

The plan was to drain the river Euphrates which ran under the city wall. Once the river bed was totally drained of water, Cyrus and his soldiers could march under the wall, through the unlocked gate, and into the city.

LET'S THINK ABOUT THIS

In a previous study relating to God's health laws, we learnt that God does not approve of alcoholic drink. The reason for this is that alcohol affects our thinking and behaviour in such a way, that it ultimately leads us away from God.

We notice that King Belshazzar and his friends were not following God. Instead, they were worshipping idols made from gold, silver, bronze, iron and wood.

LET'S THINK ABOUT THIS

Before giving the interpretation, Daniel points out the reasons why God has had to act against Belshazzar. He was consistently defiant towards God, even though he knew of all the supernatural warnings that God had given to his grandfather, King Nebuchadnezzar.

Daniel then explains the meaning of the words MENE, MENE, TEKEL, UPHARSIN. Daniel however uses the word PERES in his explanation; this is the singular form of the word UPHARSIN.

LET'S THINK ABOUT THIS

The pagan wise men were still no wiser than in the days of King Nebuchadnezzar. They could not give the meaning of the supernatural writing on the wall.

Even in our day, God communicates with us through writing. However, He does not do it as dramatically as He did in Belshazzar's day. He does it through the bible which we call “God's written word” or “the word of God”.

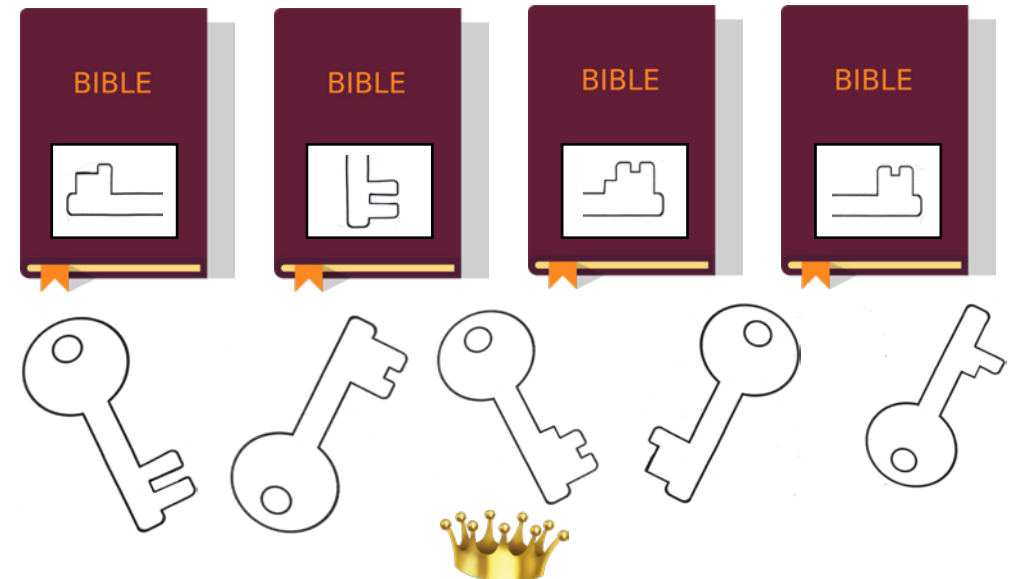
It is also very important that we have the correct meaning, or understanding, of God's word. We do this in several ways:

1. We always pray before we open our Bibles, asking God to give us the correct understanding.
2. We search the Bible to make sure that our interpretation of a specific topic is consistent, or in harmony, throughout the bible.

This is how we unlock the truth. If the key ideas fit throughout the Bible, we then have the correct key to unlock interpretation.

LET'S THINK ABOUT THIS

Fortunately the queen, Belshazzar's mother, remembered that Daniel had a reputation for solving mysteries, riddles and puzzles; that's what explaining enigmas means. So, Daniel was finally called before the frantic Belshazzar.

Many years had passed since the days of King Nebuchadnezzar. In fact, Daniel was by now an old man, having been in Babylon nearly 70 years. Despite all the pagan distractions and the luxurious lifestyle of the palace court, Daniel had remained faithful throughout this time.

It is no surprise then, that Daniel was still not interested in the promises of fame and fortune being offered in return for interpreting the supernatural text message on the wall.
