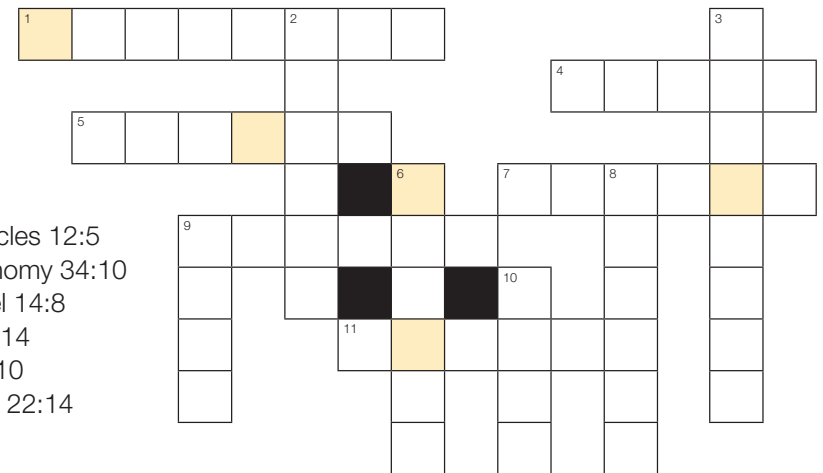
LET'S THINK ABOUT THIS

Let's learn more about prophets and why the Holy Spirit chose them. 2 Peter 1:21 says that prophets were “holy” men. Two of the earliest prophets were Enoch and Noah. The Bible says that both of them “walked with God”. In everything they did, whether it was preaching or building or whatever, they loved and obeyed God. If you love and obey God, He will see you as holy too.

Our memory verse tells us that, even though the prophets were given messages from God about His plan of salvation, they wanted to know more about it. They did certain things to do this. They “inquired and searched carefully”, meaning they prayed and studied God's other prophetic messages, to see what was already revealed about the coming Christ.

LET'S THINK ABOUT THIS

When Adam and Eve sinned, God came down to the Garden of Eden to tell them about His plan to save them. He didn't tell them every little bit of the plan, just the main points that they needed to know. As their children, grandchildren, and so on (their offspring or descendants) needed to know more, God *communicated* those things to them. He also helped them to obey Him. Sometimes Jesus Himself helped people, or gave them messages. But often He sent other workers. Some of His most important messengers are the good angels. The word “angel” actually means “messenger”. In Hebrews 1:14, angels are called “ministering spirits”.

LET'S THINK ABOUT THIS

Yesterday we learned that Jesus often sends angels to help us in the war against Satan. They teach us about God's plan and give us strength to choose what is right. If we choose to obey God, the good angels actually help us win spiritual battles against Satan and his evil angels!

But there is an even more special Helper that Jesus sends to teach us about God's plan. That is the third Person of the Godhead, the Holy Spirit. The Bible does not reveal to us a lot about the Holy Spirit. That is partly because the Holy Spirit does not speak about Himself. Instead, He points us to Jesus. But we do know that the Holy Spirit's work is essential to the plan of salvation.

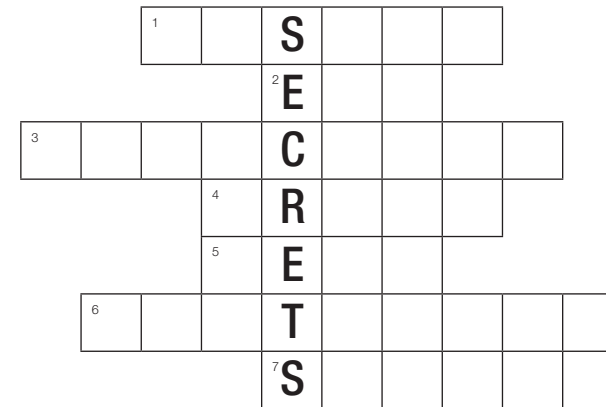
LET'S THINK ABOUT THIS

Yesterday we learned something about the Holy Spirit. He works in our hearts to draw us to Jesus and teach us about Him. His work is essential to salvation. Also, He is part of the Godhead.

One of the jobs of the Holy Spirit is to choose those who will be prophets of God. Prophets give people messages from God. The Holy Spirit reveals secrets to them, which they pass on to the people. These secrets are often called *revelations*, because they are *revealed* by the Holy Spirit.
