

More than anything, the **PROPHETS** in Old Testament times wanted to learn about the **MESSIAH** and see Him when He came to Earth. But **NONE** of them did. Jesus called John the Baptist "**MORE** than a prophet", because He announced Jesus' arrival and actually saw Him.

John wore simple **CLOTHES**, lived in the country, and ate **HEALTHY** food. He was filled with the Holy **SPIRIT**, even before he was born. John came in the spirit and power of **ELIJAH**, to prepare people to receive a Messiah who was to save them from their **SINS**.

Malachi's prophecy about Elijah is a **DUAL** prophecy. Besides predicting John the Baptist's mission at Jesus' first coming, it also tells us that, right at the **END** of time, there will be another prophetic movement, a church, who will give God's last call to the **WORLD**. Today, God invites people all over the world to join His church to prepare for **JESUS**' soon return.
