


THURSDAY


My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me? Psalm 22:1

They divide My garments among them, And for My clothing they cast lots. Psalm 22:18


Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son... Isaiah 7:14
